The Girl Scouts of Silver Sage Council offers the use of its program facilities to all Girl Scout Groups and other youth groups. Non youth groups can call for availability. A non-refundable use fee is required to finalize a reservation.

How to calculate your use fee: If you were a Girl Scout Troop with 10 girls and 3 adults using the Main Lodge at CAP for 2 nights, you would calculate as follows:

$$\begin{aligned} & \text{Non-refundable use fee} + (\# \text{campers} \times \# \text{nights} \times \$3.00 \text{ per camper per night}) \\ & = \$25.00 \text{ Non-refundable use fee} + (13 \text{ campers} \times 2 \text{ nights} \times \$3.00 \text{ per camper per night}) = \$103.00. \end{aligned}$$

Non-refundable use fee does not apply toward balance.

Non-Girl Scout Groups: Prior to the use of any property, the party using the property agrees to provide the Girl Scouts of Silver Sage Council, Inc. with the following evidence of insurance: Certificate of Comprehensive General Liability Insurance including contractual liability for bodily injury and property damage in an amount not less than \$500,000 combined single limit or \$250,000/500,000 bodily injury and \$100,000 property damage. FRIENDSHIP SQUARE (FSQ)

610 Reserve Street, Boise, ID in ADA County (Fort Boise Park-NE Boise) – A facility with meeting/conference room, kitchen, sleeping quarters, showers, patio/deck and ceremonial circle.

- ❑ Suggested “onsite” Programs and Activities: Day/Troop Camps, Cheerleading and Leadership Programs, Journaling and Artistic Expression through Painting, Sculpturing, Photography, Theater and Drama.
- ❑ Suggested “offsite” Programs and Activities: Hiking and Backpacking, Mountain Biking, Tennis, Skate Boarding, Remote Control Cars, Softball, Scuba Diving, Self Defense Classes and Running.
- ❑ Special Trips: State Capital, World Center for Birds of Prey, Boise Zoo, Discovery Center, Boise River Float Trips, Medical Centers, Water Park and Fun Center, Airport and local businesses.

CAMP ALICE PITTENGER (CAP)

2111 Pilgrim Cove Rd, McCall, ID in Valley County (3 miles/10 minutes from McCall) - A cabin style camp is located on the shores of Payette Lake, nestled among the beautiful Ponderosa Pines with a main lodge, complete kitchen, dining hall, electricity, fireplace insert, shower house, 26 bunkhouse sleeping cabins, incredible waterfront, including 2 shoreline coves with docks. Units have water and vault type latrines available summer only.

1. Suggested “onsite” Programs and Activities: Swimming, Sailing and Wind Surfing, Water Skiing, Wake and Knee Boarding, Canoeing, Sea Kayaking, Ecology, Wildlife Habitat, Crafts, Singing and Camp Fires, Star Gazing and Astronomy, Outdoor Survival, Disc Golf, Discover Wildlife, Lewis and Clark History, Nutrition, Wellness, Self Reflection, Meditation, Artistic Expression through Painting, Photography, Outdoor Writing and Drama.
 2. Suggested “offsite” Programs and Activities: Cross Country Skiing, Snowshoeing; Mountain Biking, Hiking, Fishing, Backpacking, GPS, Orienteering and Challenge Course.

PINE CREEK RANCH (PCR)

152 Pine Creek Rd, Shoup, ID 83469, in Lemhi County (45 miles/65 minutes NW of Salmon) – A dormitory style camp, PCR located in the Salmon/Challis National Forest, near the Salmon River and Frank Church Wilderness Area, with a main lodge, complete kitchen, dining hall, fireplace insert, 3 dormitory style sleeping quarters, 8 bunkhouse cabins, health center, shower house, horse barn with corrals and a 20kw generator power supply. Units have vault type latrines and water in summer.

- ❑ Suggested “onsite” Programs and Activities: Horseback Riding, Back Country Horse Camping, Hiking, Backpacking, GPS, Compass, Orienteering, Outdoor Cooking, Camp Fires and Songs, Habitat Conservation Projects and Programs, Wildlife and Plant Identification, Photography, Drama, Survival Preparedness, Rescue, Archery and Ranching.
- ❑ Suggested “offsite” Programs and Activities: River Rafting, Kayaking, Fishing, Jet Boat Excursions and Mountain Biking.
- ❑ Special Trips: the Sacagawea Center, Wilderness Area, Hot Springs, Old Gold Mines, the Big Horn Crags, Wildlife Viewing, and Cattle Drives.

Swan Valley, ID in Bonneville County (55 miles/90 minutes E of Idaho Falls) – A tent style camp, TAM is located in the Targhee/Caribou National Forest, near Palisades Reservoir on the Snake River, with a main lodge, complete kitchen, dining hall, fireplace insert, shower house, 10 tent sites, 5 bunkhouse cabins, horse barn with corrals and a 20kw generator power supply. Units have vault type latrines and water in summer, some areas with flush toilets.

- ❑ Suggested “onsite” Programs and Activities: Horse Back Riding, Camping, Sand Volleyball, Archery, Crafts, Campfires and Songs, Trail Hiking, GPS, Compass, Orienteering, Outdoor Cooking, Plant and Wildlife Identification, Photography and Drama.
- ❑ Suggested “offsite” Programs and Activities: Canoeing, Fly Fishing, Backpacking and Camping.
- ❑ Special trips: Fall Creek Falls, Hot Air Balloon Festival, Palisades Reservoir on the Snake River and Golf.
