

SERVICE UNIT TROOP COACH

Your Role as the Service Unit Troop Coach

As Service Unit Troop Coach you will be available to provide support to troop leaders on aspects of program delivery and troop management. Duties are determined in partnership with the Service Unit Director and may include: guiding new leaders during their first year, sharing grade-level expertise with new and bridging leaders, facilitating leader discussions at Service Unit meetings, and assisting with Service Unit or Council trainings.

Term: One year, renewable

Estimated Time Commitment: Varies from five (5) to ten (10) hours per month.

Skills/Experience Needed:

- Troop Leader for at least 2 years
- Willingness to stay up-to-date on the necessary leader trainings and resource materials

Responsibilities

Based on your desires and your Service Unit Director's needs, you will customize your role as Troop Coach from this set of possibilities, or together design your specific role:

- Be a "buddy" where you will work with one or two specific leaders.
- Be grade-level coach where you will be a mentor for all new leaders at a specific grade level.
- Be an as-needed expert in Program and be familiar with the latest procedures and resources associated with Program design and delivery.
- Be an as-needed expert in Troop Management and be familiar with the latest procedures and resources associated with Troop Management.
- Participate in facilitating mini Service Unit trainings at Service Unit meetings.
- Facilitate grade-level round-table sessions at your Service Unit meetings.
- Attend and assist at Learn & Lead and other council Enrichment trainings.
