Rookie of the Year: This pin honors a **first-year Troop Leader** (at any grade level) who has:

- Must be an active registered volunteer.
- Successfully completed the basic leadership training.
- Participated in at least two events or meetings beyond the troop level.
- Demonstrated outstanding performance in helping girls develop courage, confidence, and character.
- Consistently lives by the Girl Scout Promise and Law.

- Provided exceptional service in support of the Girl Scout mission.
- Has demonstrated a strong commitment to helping girls develop courage, confidence, and character, and live by the Girl Scout Law.
