"Mom & Me" Booth Sales

In order to give opportunities to those girls who continue to strive for their personal goals, we allow one mom and one Girl Scout to host booth sales. A "mom" can be any adult that the parent/guardian allows the Girl Scout to sell cookies with, and s/he does not need to be an approved volunteer. We ask that parents/guardians use their best judgment and select someone they can trust with their girl, cookies and money.* To participate in the Mom and Me Booth Sales, the following conditions must be met:

Guidelines:

- Adults must sign this Mom and Me Booth Sales Contract and submit it to their Troop Cookie Manager or Troop Leader. NO OTHER PERSONS MAY BE PRESENT AT THE MOM AND ME BOOTH SALE, INCLUDING SIBLINGS.
- The troop must agree that they have signed up for as many locations as desired prior to Mom and Me sign ups.
- The parent/guardian is financially responsible for all cookies and money in their girl's possession.
- Troop Leaders should ensure that they received a signed cookie program permission slip for every girl selling in their troop.
- The Girl Scout selling MUST remain present at an open booth.
- The girl must be identifiable as a Girl Scout.
- Do NOT block entrances or exits of the establishment and only approach customers EXITING.
- Each girl/mom will be responsible for providing cash for change and a container to keep it safe.
- Bring your own supplies: tables chairs, signage, pens/pencils, calculator, etc.
- Avoid eating, drinking, and chewing gum at booths.
- Bring lots of smiles, good manners, and a polite voice. Say "please" and "thank you". Be considerate to others.
- LEAVE THE AREA CLEANER THAN YOU FOUND IT! Take empty cases back home to recycle.
- Protect the cookies! Keep them out of direct sun and dampness.
- Count cookies and money at the beginning and end of each shift to make sure you balance.
- Remember, only girls sell Girl Scout Cookies.

I agree to perform the above responsibilities. I agree that the cookies I accept become my financial responsibility while in my possession, and records must be maintained and submitted appropriately.
