

Girl Scouts of Silver Sage welcomes youth and volunteer members in any financial situation.

Camp Scholarships

Girl Scouts of Silver Sage is committed to providing opportunities for all girls to experience camp. If your family or Girl Scout would benefit from financial assistance, please select "Financial Aid" as your payment type when registering for camp. A registration deposit of \$50 is required from every camper to reserve your spot at camp. If you do not receive the scholarship amount requested, you can receive a full refund of payments, including the \$50 deposit. Once you register for camp with "Financial Aid" as your payment type, you will receive an email from Silver Sage with a link to the scholarship request form. You will need to complete this form for your request to be reviewed. Each request is considered on an individual basis, and decisions are based on the girl's need and availability of funds. We ask that Program Credits and earned rewards (e.g. "2025 Bonus Council Adventure Credits") be utilized whenever possible. There is a limit of one scholarship per girl.

Any requests received after the review period will be considered until funds are depleted. Camperships are still available today! Fill out <u>Camp Financial Aid Form</u> and <u>Register Now</u>.



Hi Campers!




CIT II






