Girl Scouts of Silver Sage Camp Code of Conduct

Our mission is to build girls of courage, confidence and character who make the world a better place. Our camps are committed to creating an environment modeled after the Girl Scout Promise and Law.

This form is required for ALL girl and adult campers, for each session attended. Family Camp participants may use one form. Parents/guardians and campers: please read carefully, and sign.

Camp Code of Conduct

I understand that my attitude and behavior are critical to the success of the camping session; therefore, for the good of the camp, as well as my fellow group members, I agree to abide by the following:

1. I will follow the principles of the Girl Scout Promise and Law.
2. I will cooperate with the camp staff and be sensitive to the needs of my fellow campers.
3. I will participate in program activities as well as Camp Kapers (daily housekeeping duties) and clean up.
4. I will respect the people and places with which I come in contact.
5. I will do my best to work out any conflict (argument) in a calm and respectful manner. I will also go to my counselors or other adults if I am having any problems with other people.
6. I will stand up for other people and go to adult counselors for assistance if someone is being mistreated.
7. I will show respect for myself and others by being responsible for my words and actions toward other campers and camp staff. I understand that teasing, gossiping, intimidating and bullying is not acceptable behavior.
8. I will respect others' personal space and belongings, keep my hands to myself and maintain appropriate boundaries by avoiding unwanted physical touch, including play fighting or pranks.

9. I understand it is unacceptable to create alliances “cliques” and written or verbal contracts used to exclude anyone at any time or reason.
10. I know it is unacceptable to have conversations of an adult nature such as, illegal substances, sexual content or violent activities.
11. I understand that the use of tobacco, alcohol, drugs, and vapes will not be tolerated, and will result in dismissal from camp.
12. I understand that I am not allowed to bring fireworks, knives, weapons, or look-a-likes to camp. I understand if I bring any of these items, I will be sent home.
13. I understand that I cannot bring food or candy to camp.
14. I understand I cannot bring pets to camp. I am only allowed to bring service animals with prior approval.
15. I understand it is unacceptable to use any medication that has not been turned into program health center. All Medication including over the counter medication must be turned into program health center except for asthma inhalers and epi pens.
16. I understand that the wearing of jewelry, clothing, accessories, or manners of grooming related to illegal substances or sexual content is unacceptable.
17. I will treat equipment (i.e., tents, mattresses, etc.) provided by Girl Scouts Silver Sage and/or an outside provider(s) with care.
18. I will observe all safety rules and regulations established for program, recreational and personal activities. I will report all injuries or illnesses to the camp staff.
19. I will maintain appropriate relationships at camp. Camp is not the place to have a romantic relationship.
20. I understand that I cannot use camp facilities or the waterfront after dark or without a facilitator present.
21. I understand it is unacceptable to leave the group without permission or leave camp property without a staff member. The buddy system and adult supervision is required at all times at camp and on trips.
22. I understand that if I am involved in any unacceptable behavior, I will receive two warnings. For girls, after two warnings, my parents/guardian’s will be called, and I will be sent home. I understand if I am sent home, it will be my parents/guardian’s responsibility to pick me up at any time of the day or night and that any additional expense incurred will be their responsibility. For adults, after two warnings you and your family will be asked to leave.
