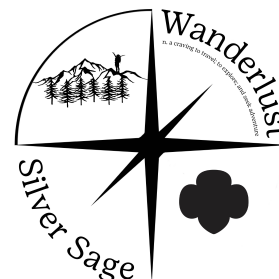

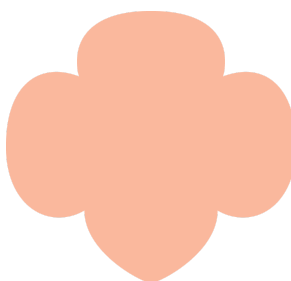

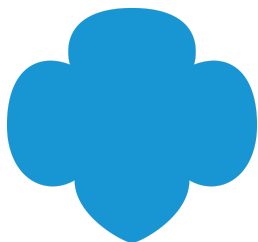

Each membership year, all Girl Scout troops must submit their Annual Troop Finance Report by June 1, 2022. This report can be accessed via the Volunteer toolkit on "MyGS". Along with the report, troops will need to submit all troop account statements from May 2021-April 2022, which must include a brief description for each credit/debit and signatures of the two approved signers on each month.

If this report is not submitted and received by the submission date, the troop bank account may be frozen and become non-accessible until the report is submitted.
