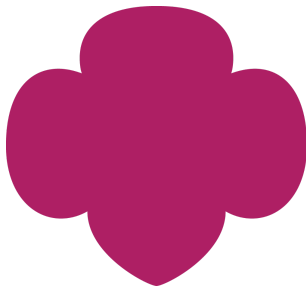

Have You Signed Up For Camp Doc?

Policy Update: Event Refund Timeline



Refunds for Council program events will now only be granted if written cancellations are received **two weeks prior** to the event.

Full refunds are issued after the two-week mark for council programs only if the program is full, cancelled, or in the event of a serious illness or death in the family. For serious illness, a doctor's written note is required within one week after the program takes place.

Our previous policy allowed refunds to be granted prior to the registration deadlines, which will continue to be from approximately 1 day – 1 week prior to the program. Thank you for your understanding.

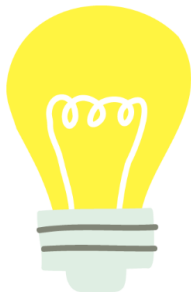
2024 Summer Fun Challenge is Here!

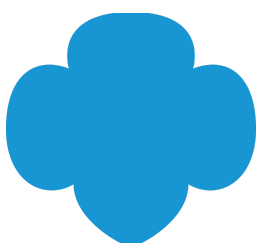

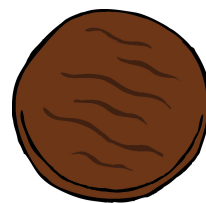
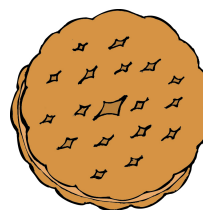
