- A Silver Sage Girl Scout Gold Award recipient
- Have graduated high school in 2026.
- Be enrolled in an accredited college, university, or trade school for Fall 2026 semester.

Applications must be:

- Complete, typed, and free of errors.
- Accompanied by
 - One letter of recommendation addressing your achievements in the areas of leadership and service. This letter may not be from a family member or your troop leader.
 - Evidence of enrollment/acceptance into an accredited college, university or trade school.
- Received at the GSSSC office no later than July 1, 2026. There are two options to submit.
