

## GIRL CODE OF CONDUCT

## **Girl Scout Promise:**

On my honor, I will try:
To serve God\* and my
country, To help people at all
times, And to live by the Girl
Scout Law.

\* Girls may substitute for the word "God" in accordance to their beliefs.

## **Girl Scout Law:**

I will do my best to be honest and fair, friendly and helpful, considerate and caring, courageous and strong, and responsible for what I say and do, and to respect myself and others, respect authority, use resources wisely, make the world a better place, and be a sister to every Girl Scout.

As a Member of Girl Scouts, I agree to the following:

- 1. I will follow the principles of the Girl Scout Promise and Law as outlined in this Code of Conduct.
- 2. I will follow all rules that help protect others and myself, and that ensure program activities are safe, fun, and successful.
- 3. I will treat other people, myself, property, and equipment with respect.
- 4. I will be considerate of the feelings of others.
- 5. I will be respectful toward my Girl Scout Leaders. I will not argue with them or call them names. If I have questions or feel disappointed, I will express myself calmly and respectfully.
- 6. I will not bully or harm my fellow Girl Scouts. This includes hitting, slapping, spitting, or any unwanted physical contact. I understand that violence will not be tolerated, and my parents, as well as the parents of those involved will be notified.
- 7. I understand that others may have thoughts and ideas that are different from mine, and I will respect those differences. I will not make fun of others' ideas or try to offend anyone with my own.

## **Consequences for Breaking the Code of Conduct:**

- First Offense: Review of the Girl Scout Promise & Law, and an apology, if appropriate.
- Second Offense: Review of the Girl Scout Promise & Law, apology if appropriate, and parent will be notified
- Third Offense: Review of the Girl Scout Promise and Law with both the girl and parent. A meeting will be held to discuss the need for parental supervision at future meetings.
- Fourth Offense: A discussion will take place about possibly transitioning the member to a different participation option.
