

Earned FREE Overnight at GSSSC Council Properties – What your troop needs to know!

Properties included: Friendship Square (Camp Echo), Camp Alice Pittenger, Camp TAM

This FREE Overnight is for Troop camping only. Girls and adult volunteers who renewed for the coming year may attend. You may purchase an additional night if available.



What to expect from each property and what is included:

Camp Echo:

Your troop will have a large room to lay pallets or to practice tent camping indoors, there is a separate room for adults with 2 twin beds. An indoor modern kitchen and outdoor fire pit is available for use. Bathrooms and showers are on site. You may hike in the foothills, work on cooking or outdoors badges, camp songs, skits and Girl Scout traditions. You will want to bring all bedding and food with you. When booking your overnight, your troop will be the only troop on site.

Camp Alice Pittenger:

Your troop will have access to non-electric cabins in the warmer months (you will need to provide your own lighting at night) and electric cabins in the winter months (electric cabins have an overhead light, and small space heater). Your troop will have access to a shower house with bathrooms and showers. Cooking is allowed on camp stoves or fire pit in designated area. Fires allowed only if safe to do so. Swimming, archery, canoeing and other activities found in the Safety Activity Checkpoints that require trained instructors are not included in your stay. You will want to plan activities like hiking, working on outdoors badges, camp songs, skits and Girl Scout traditions. Cabins have bunks with mattress, bedding will need to be brought with you. When booking CAP, you will share the campground with other registered Girl Scouts. Not included in your stay: O'Conner House, The Lodge.

Camp Ta-Man-A-Wis:

This is a remote camp in Swan Valley, ID with limited access during a short summer season. This is a great camp for backpacking, tent camping, and deep wilderness adventures. There are limited non-electric cabins. This camp is off grid, so plan accordingly. Please inquire with Customer Care if you are interested in learning more about this unique opportunity. Camp TAM will be approved for your troop on an individual basis.

You will need to book your stay through our website under Camp Rentals and then turn in an Intent to Travel for your troop to be approved through Customer Care at customercare@girlscouts-ssc.org. Volunteer trainings will need to be completed prior to trip approval.
